

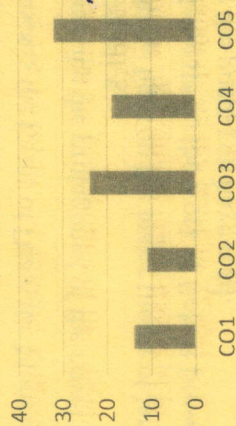

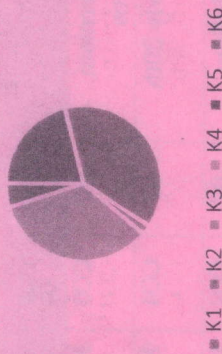

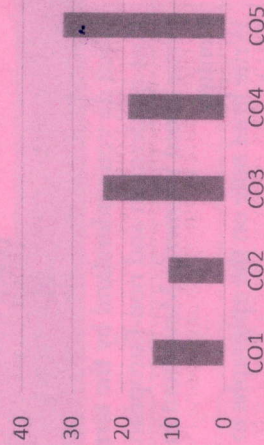

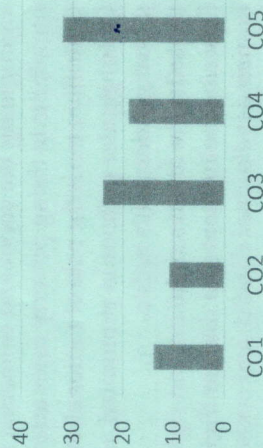
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

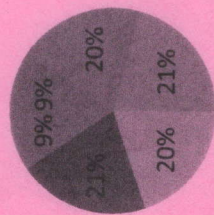

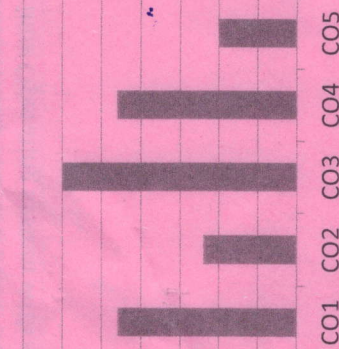
