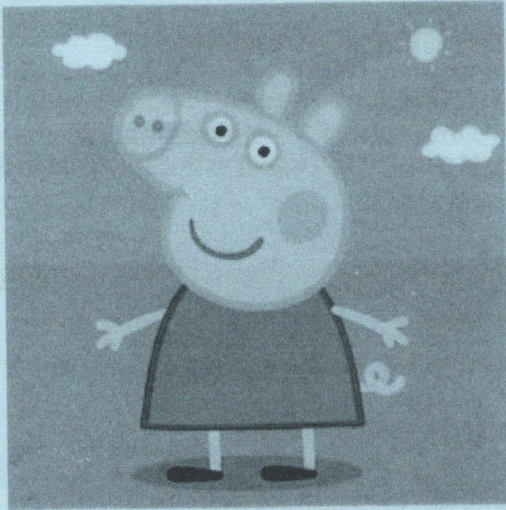

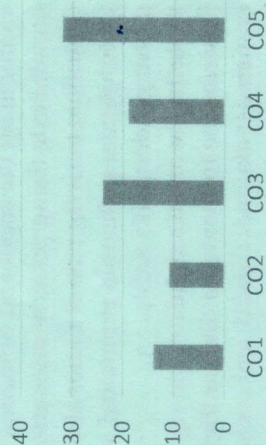
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

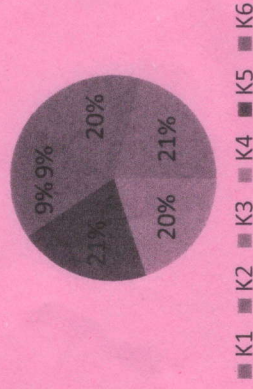

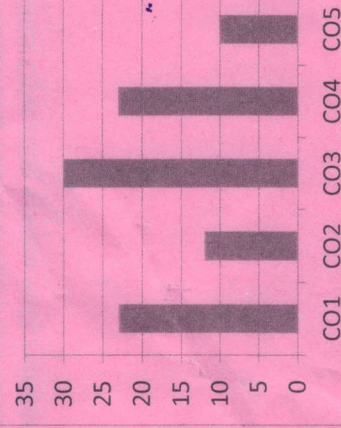
